GIJAPA is now sending the weekly sermons electronically to 8 of the 12 AM radio stations in the US and 3 of the 5 short-wave stations for broadcasting. This saves us thousands of dollars in postage and supplies as well as time.



PTL! We are in another special month, a month that finalizes all activities in year 2006. Though we fell sick. had problems, suffered in a way, had bad business we are alive and kicking all by the graciousness and mercies of God the Almighty. Every one of us is doing very well here in the family and we are very grateful unto the Lord for all He has done for us bad and good. It was 1 year when the Lord tested our faith with that robbery, but by His own grace, He kept us comforted and strong through your prayers, support and words of encouragements. We are doing the soul winning job God called us to do for Him; and that is what we shall do even if the going gets tougher! Please pray for us!

THE Truth's activities for the year were successful. Our village-to-village work was tremendously better than last year. We talked to several people (approximately 5,000) in 9 small villages and 3 towns. The traditional festival opened the way for us to have more people to talk to, as many people traveled to visit friends and love ones. We are starting some congregations in at least three villages in the next year if the Lord willing. Negotiations are underway for structures or meeting places as well as materials for these congregations. At the moment, souls that have been won for the Lord travel from their various villages to worship with us in our congregation (whose weekly giving is below \$20) supports these villagers with their transportation cost every week.

We say a very BIG THANK YOU for the clothes for the people in the villages around where we work and those in our congregation, as well as, those out side of our congregation--May the Lord richly bless you Ed and Naomi for soliciting this clothes for these people including ourselves. Many people now have something to wear for church and other activities. The children's clothing especially what we were thinking about; God bless you for the clothes for them too.

The GIJAPA 'T' Shirt is a talk of the town and many are worshipping with us all because of the 'T' Shirt. You may say this is not right but to me it is another way to win souls for Christ. People say the inscription "GOD IS JUST A PRAYER AWAY" on the 'T' Shirt is what 'kills' them. Truly, in Grana due to the economic hardship and the spread news and evil, people are running into and flooding churches and prayer centers for rescue. People are more powerful than before, so with such an inscription, people feel encouraged in the Lord. Unfortunately, the 'T' Shirt is no longer being printed due to lack of funds. OUR PRAYER REQUEST AND URGENT NEED

GIJAPA has been very prompt with our requests for materials for the work we are doing here. Today we can boast of thousands of people reading their own Bibles either in English or in their own languages. This includes Bibles sent by GIJAPA, as well as Bibles we buy in our local language. More requests for the lessons are pouring in and we are doing our very best to satisfy everybody who asks for the lessons and a Bible, but with a very special care. Today, elderly men and women are reading the Bible without straining their eyes due to the Large Print Bibles. We still need more Bibles both in English and in Local Languages and also Large Print Bibles. At the time of going to press, we have requests for 3,821 English Bibles, 614 Large Print Bibles and 763 Bibles in our local languages from individuals and churches from Grana, Togo and Ivory Coast. We are traveling on commercial vehicles for all of our activities and we think it about time we get our own vehicle for the work we are doing. The charges are exorbitant by these commercial vehicles--over \$800 yearly. There are many reasons too: The risk involved in traveling on commercial vehicles--no insurance, they over load, the rickety nature of the cars, diseases, the delay in off loading and picking passengers on the way. Please, pray for us to be able to buy our own car in the coming year 2007. I have been involved in 13 automobile accidents since the start of this project. As I am speaking, I have problems with my neck, my chest, cracks in my head, left foot is not good, and a problem with my left hand, but I am coping with them. Thanks and may God bless you as you keep praying for us.
