IN THE MIDST OF TWO THIEVES

COMMUNION MEDITATION

In the gospel according to John chapter 19, "They took Jesus therefore: and he went out, bearing the cross for himself, unto the place called The Place Of A Skull, which is called in Hebrew Golgotha: where they crucified him, and with him two others," that Mark identifies as thieves, and Jesus in the midst. Mark informs us at that time the scripture was fulfilled in Isaiah 53:12, "And he was numbered with the transgressors."

Jesus had a police record in Jerusalem. And the Devil must have thought the dying between two thieves would add to the shame of dying on the cross. But to Jesus the bearing of the cross was the instrument of victory over the tyranny of death. Jesus had predicted in Matthew 16, "Upon this rock, I will build my church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it." Jesus used the cross as a battering ram to knock the gates of Hades off its hinges, and the insult of two thieves dying on crosses with Jesus added glory to the cross in the salvation of the one who was crucified with him.

In fact the salvation of the one thief may be looked upon as a greater miracle than the breaking of the rocks in the earthquake the moment Jesus died.

Jesus did not die between two apostles or two prophets, lest some would worship them, and share the glory of Christ with others. Jesus is the one who died for me, and when He died for me, He died for all my sins, and there was not even one left to be burned off in the imaginary fires, of an imaginary purgatory.

So look at the three crosses again. On one cross was the Savior, on one cross was the sinner saved, and on the other cross was the sinner damned. Jesus was not crucified on the altar in the Temple, where His blood mingled with the blood of lambs: He was crucified on the cross where His blood was mingled with the blood of thieves.

It is true that Jesus was numbered with the transgressor, but the two thieves were not the only transgressors. Paul says in 2nd Corinthians 5:21, "Him who knew no sin was made to be sin on our behalf; that we might be made the righteousness of God through him." The bottom line of the crucifixion for us is that Jesus was numbered with the transgressors, that we might be numbered among the names of the redeemed in the Lamb's book of Life.



NOT FAR FROM THE **KINGDOM**

In the twelfth chapter of Mark, a Scribe asked the Lord about the greatest commandment Jesus told him, "Hear, O Israel: The Lord thy God is one and thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy mind and with all thy strength. The second is this; Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these."

The Scribe said, "Of a truth Master thou hast well said that He is one and there is none other but He: And to love Him with all thine heart and with all thine understanding and with all thine strength and to love his neighbor as himself is more than all burnt offering and sacrifice." When Jesus heard that he answered discreetly, He said unto him, "THOU ART NOT FAR FROM THE KINGDOM OF GOD."

Here was a man who was not far from the Kingdom of God in point of time. It would be just about two months and the Apostles would be baptized in the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost. They would preach the Gospel and men would cry out, "What must we do?" Peter would tell them to repent and be immersed in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

We can't help but wonder if this Scribe was one of those who gladly received His Word on that day. Of course, we won't know in this world. Many, like this Scribe, are also not far from the Kingdom of God.

Some of you already believe that Jesus died for your sins. You have already repented, and you are living as good a life as you can at the moment. You have not yet obeyed the Lord in the ordinance of being immersed for the remission of sins. "YOU ARE NOT FAR FROM THE KING-DOM OF GOD."

Then again, in point of time, many of you are not far from the Kingdom of God. You are in a Church service. You hear the Gospel proclaimed. The water is warmed. The robes are ready. They are singing the invitation hymn. You are urged to respond. If you should walk down the aisle with a repentant heart and confess that Jesus is the Christ, it is quite possible that within five minutes you could be immersed for the remission of sins. THOU ART NOT FAR FROM THE KINGDOM OF GOD.

One thing is for sure. If you are not far from the Kingdom of God, you can't stay in that condition for very long. You will either enter into the Kingdom of God or you will get farther and farther away.

The author of the following lines is unknown to me: So near to the Kingdom! Yet what didst thou lack? So near to the Kingdom! What keepeth thee back? Renounce every idol, though dear it may be, And come to the Saviour now pleading for thee. So near, that thou hearest the songs that resound, From those who, believing, a pardon have found! So near, yet unwilling to give up thy sin, When Jesus is waiting to welcome thee in! To die with no hope! Hast thou counted the cost? To die out of Christ, and thy soul to be lost? So near to the Kingdom! Oh come, we implore! While Jesus is pleading, come enter the door!

The situation is still the same and even worse. She needs your prayer and support.
