Communion Meditation

Jesus fed five thousand with five loaves and two fishes. The multitude wanted to make Him king, and to escape the crowd He went up into a mountain to pray. The apostles got into the boat to return to the other side. John informs us it was now dark and the sea was rising by reason of a great wind that blew. During the storm Jesus looked down, and saw them toiling at the rowing. He watched them row that boat against the wind for about seven or eight hours. We know this because He came to them in the fourth watch of the night. They had rowed all that time, and had only gone about three and a half miles. Then Jesus came to them at about three o'clock in the morning walking upon the sea.

According to Matthew 14:16 when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, it is a ghost, and they cried out for fear. But straightway Jesus spoke unto them, saying, "Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid."

The word spirit in this verse means phantom, or ghost. And cried out indicates they shrieked, or screamed. They thought Jesus was a phantom, a ghost, a specter, something

Now the disciples knew the boat was real, they knew the wind was real, they knew the sea was real; they knew they were in real danger of dying a real death by drowning, and they knew this was no nightmare. Every thing about this situation was real; except one thing, Jesus was a phantom, a ghost: unreal.

We wonder how many people today think Jesus is a phantom, he is unreal. Today many are living in fantasyland. The church is a fantasy, and has no real purpose in life. The Bible is not real; it is a collection of myths, like Hans Christian Anderson's fairy tales, and even most members of the church never bother to read it. Baptism has no relevance to salvation at all: an empty form by which we join a church. The Lord's Supper is a meaningless ceremony where people eat a little piece of bread, and take a sip of grape juice, and many ignore it altogether, especially if there is something else they would rather do.

The disciples found out that Jesus was not a phantom; Jesus was for real, and the only real answer to the problem of certain destruction. Times have not changed; Christ is the answer, and the only answer, the one and only way of escape from the horrible future that looms before the human race.

Sin is for real, the Devil is for real, and Jesus is for real, the cross on which Jesus died for our sins is for real, the church Jesus established in the New Testament on the Day of Pentecost is for real. Dying is a real event for everybody, no exemptions, hell is for real, heaven is for real, the second coming of Jesus is for real, and the Judgment Day is for real. And the Lord's Supper is a real testimony of remembrance of a real event concerning our salvation. The Lord's Supper of Jesus Christ is not only real-it is the real deal

Thanks so much in the Lord. We salute you so much in the Lord, brother. What we need are Bibles, Clothing and Shoes. We thank you so much. We have many refugees in our midst and I suffer so much providing for them. The Church here is poor and I don't bother them for such needs. I know if they have they would help but the brethren here are poor, that is the fact.

I do the work not only in the Gambia but in the surrounding countries as well, so I need Bibles. I was on a mission work to Sierra Leone last month and next month I am to be in Senegal, The brethren keeps calling me to come and assist. In most cases many have questions bothering them on some Bible subjects. When I go and give them the Biblical answers to their questions, they get their faith increased and many visitors to the Church give their life. God is indeed great, my brother. The Gambia is a very hard soil and we now have four congregations, I met only one from Ghana. In Ghana, I can preach on the street and about fifty souls will just give their life the same day, whilst in the Gambia if a preacher does not take care he may not baptize even just one person the whole year. Many preachers come and go, they can't work. The Gambia comprises of over 90% Muslims whilst In Ghana they are less than 8%. This is the reason I am happy you are focusing your attention on hard soils like The Gambia. The Good Lord will always abide with you in Jesus' name, Amen. Please we need more Bibles and clothing. In any country I visit the first thing they ask from me is Bibles, and in The Gambia also Bibles are needed so much. To get a Bible to buy in this country is not even easy, and if you see one for sale also you cannot afford the price. I posted a calendar of the women's fellowship here to you and I hope you will receive soon. I salute Sister Naomi in the Lord the women say the calendar is for her. I know she is assisting you so much in the Lord's work, peace from God be upon you, nice family. I salute Sister Naomi in the Lord. Thanks so

much, brother. Amen to His Glory.

My name is Alex L. and I'm in Washington County, Fayetteville, Arkansas. I've used drugs since I was 14 and I've been stealing others stuff since I was at least 9 and the last year I've really took a lot from people most these people I never knew and never will. The people around me helped me to get rid of stealing stuff so we could get money to get high, these people would steal from me every time I turned my back. Couldn't trust anyone, not my girl friend, not my X-wife, not my close friends and even a lot of my family. Believe it or not, I always wanted what my parents had: marriage, kids, house, cars, and job, but I always went about it the wrong way.

Looking as my past I can say how could I be so foolish? I never seen good people because I wasn't good and my idea of good was a lot different than others. Now I see good people everywhere, Mr. Bousman Jesus has given me my sight back. You are a saint you send Bibles to people all over the US. Dear Ed,

I listen to your programme on Radio Sri Lanka every Sunday at 8 AM. I was encouraged by your message and would be happy if you could mail me a copy of it. For many years we did not have a shortwave radio but got repaired and we're delighted to hear your programme. We were in W. Africa as "Tent Making" Christians, but in 1990 due to the Civil War we miraculously escaped and were airlifted by US Marines onto their warship and finally came to India. We lost everything, but never lost hope in God. Since we had 2 small sons, the struggle for my husband, Simon was much to reestablish the family from scratch, he over worked long hours as a result his health got affected with chronic diabetes in 1998, he lost his sight in right eye due to blood clot, his left eye underwent laser treatment, he had to give up his accounting job, and in 2005 his kidneys failed and now he is on dialysis 3 times a week.
