

THE SOLDIERS Communion Meditation John 19:23-24

The soldiers therefore, when they crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts; to every soldier a part and also the coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout. They said therefore one to another, "Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled," which saith, "They parted My garments among them, and upon My vesture they did cast lots." Matthew adds this statement: "And they sat and watched Him there."

Concerning the Lord's Supper there are five items of interest in this action of the soldiers.

Number one: The Bible is the inspired word of God. The prophecy about dividing the garments of Jesus was prophesied about 1,000 years before it happened in Psalms 22:18: "They parted My garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture."

Number two: They parted My garments among them. They all had a part in the crucifixion, and so did we. In Romans 5:6, "For while we were yet weak, in due season Christ died for the ungodly." Romans 3:23, "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God."

Number three: Before Jesus was crucified they took off of Him the purple robe, and put on Him His garments. The same blood soaked garments He wore in the Garden of Gethsemane. Concerning that blood Peter declared in 1st Peter 1:18-19, "Ye were redeemed, not with corruptible things, with silver or gold, from your vain manner of life handed down from your fathers, but with precious blood, as of a Lamb without blemish and without spot, even the blood of Christ."

Number four: Jesus was crucified on the cross strip stark naked. This was a part of the same song we sing about in the gospel song: "To the Old Rugged Cross I will ever be true, Its shame and reproach gladly bear." Number five: And they sat and watched Him there. To the soldiers the spectacle of the crucifixion was a show. "They sat and watched Him there".

I went to a church service on a Wednesday night and there were about forty people present. Before services I heard the people behind me comment what a great meeting they had the night before on Tuesday, an off night and had four hundred present. I asked what happened? They said that they enjoyed the music of a quartet.

While the contents of a gospel song can have a wonderful message and can be a wonderful program, and well worth the attendance one cannot help but wonder in this case; how many came to worship, and how many came to sit and watch the show?

Paul tells us in 1st Corinthians 11:28 regarding the Lord's Supper: "But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup." E.B.

PORTRAIT OF SALVATION

Communion Meditation

The PORTRAIT OF SALVATION is reproduced in the life of the redeemed. When Jesus died, He died on the cross. In like manner we also must die on the cross. Paul tells us in Galatians 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ, and it is no longer I that live, but Christ liveth in me." And then again in Romans 6:6: "Our old man was crucified with Him." Also in Galatians 5:24: "And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the passions and the lusts thereof."

Jesus died on the cross, and we must be crucified on the cross. The portrait of the crucifixion of Jesus is reproduced in the life of the redeemed.

But notice further when Jesus died it was necessary that He be buried. It is also necessary that we be buried. Earth is earth, and water is water. When a person is buried in physical death a hole is dug, and he is buried and covered up. When we die on our cross we must be buried and covered up. Paul tells us about that burial in Romans 6:4 when he says, "We were buried with Him in baptism." We were lowered into the water, and buried out of sight.

Jesus was buried after He was crucified, and we must be buried after we are crucified. The portrait of the burial of Christ in the tomb is reproduced in the burial in baptism of the redeemed.

There is a third element in the portrait of the death of our Lord. After the Lord's dead body was buried, He was raised up on the third day. The angel at the tomb said, "He is not here, for He is risen even as He said."

We must also be raised up from our watery grave. Paul tells us in Colossians 2:12, "Buried with Him in baptism wherein ye were also raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. Again in Romans 6:4, "As Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so also we might walk in newness of life."

Jesus was raised from the dead, and we having died to sin need to be raised up also. The portrait of the resurrection of Jesus on the third day is reproduced in the life of the redeemed.

Now let us look at the whole portrait of salvation. Jesus the Redeemer died on the cross, was buried, and raised from the dead, and the redeemed in like manner duplicate the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. And that completes the PORTRAIT OF THE REDEEMER'S' SALVA-TION AS REPRODUCED IN THE LIFE OF THE REDEEMED.

This collaboration between THE TRUTH & GIJAPA have been very successful since its commencement in 2005. The Truth's soul winning work has seen a tremendous change since then with more souls won unto Christ through the Bible Study Lessons, door-to-door preaching, Ed's Sermon Translation Program, Distribution of Used Clothing, and Film Shows. So far we have a total of 42 baptized souls between January 2009 and now (April10). Though it is very difficult these days to have people listen to you especially when you are not bringing or not going to talk about money, this number is still small and we need to do more. We have traveled to 16 small villages and towns since January and were glad we've been in such hinterlands but sorry to see and hear what we saw and heard about the people. Finally, there is a church at Agona Nkwanta for the people and the brethren in this town. with us doing the fundamental job, the Bawjiase Church of Christ also evangelized the town without knowing that we were working there to plant the church and will take full control in the running and managing of it so that The Truth won't spend money on it supporting anybody. The big work had already been done so everything was ready for the go. However, 5 of the brethren have made up their minds to worship with us at Park Side bearing their own transportation cost. We are so glad and we thank God for this. Now we can turn to other places for the planting of churches. Thanks you for your prayers.

OTHER CONGREGATIONS

Park Side Church of Christ, Fianko Church of Christ and the Unexpected Church of Christ are all doing very fine with many joining. Brethren from Park Side are visiting and strengthening these congregations in shifts every Sunday. This helps in growing the churches. We are changing our church-planting strategy beginning with the next village or town we go to from Agona Nwkanta. We are not going to base the membership on a big number and we won't spend a year or more in planting the church. We shall see the chief of the town or village to tell him about our intension to plant a congregation of the Church of Christ in his town if he agrees (which is 100% likely that he will agree), we shall then ask that a gong-gong is beating to meet all the people to talk to them about the church, how it is ran, it's programs and answer questions from the people so that with the number of people we get through this peoples' assembly, the church would be planted teaching these people till they are baptized. This I know will work faster and save us a lot of money. We have never relented in our efforts to plant more Churches of Christ in every town or village where there is none. We pray that God will in end the say to us, "WELL DONE GOOD SERVANT!" Keep praying for us as we plan to go into another town or village right away.

We thank God that through this economic hardship, you are still donating to get Bibles to the needy. God will keep blessing you for placing a Bible in the hands of the people to read about God. We still need more Bibles than ever. Our Bible request list is soaring everyday but unfortunately, we are unable to meet the demand. Please, keep helping and you get it back in abundance. 
