

### A NON-CONVERSION Acts 24:24-27

In Acts 24 is the account of the preaching of the Gospel, that resulted in a non-conversion. Paul, a prisoner has been called into the presence of Governor Felix, and his wife Drusilla; who desired to hear him concerning the faith in Christ Jesus.

Felix a former slave had arisen to the rank of Governor, and was not above any manner of evil including murder. Drusilla was given in marriage to a small time king as a teenager, and Felix on a visit to the King, used a sorcerer to lure her away from him, and at this time she was living in open adultery with Felix. And this was the audience Paul a prisoner had at this time.

Now what kind of a message would Paul preach to an audience like this? It would appear to most modern day preachers that Paul made a tactical blunder in the message he preached that day, as he reasoned of righteousness, selfcontrol, and the judgment to come. As he preached, he reasoned with them. In Isaiah 1:18 the prophet said, "Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool." If there, ever was a man, or a woman that needed to hear a message as to how to have their crimson, scarlet sins made white as snow, it was Felix and Drusilla.

#### RIGHTEOUSNESS

First it was necessary in this message of Paul to Felix and Drusilla concerning the faith in Christ Jesus to reason with them about righteousness. What statement would be any better to begin than what he would say in Romans in the third chapter: "There is none righteous, no not one: There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. They have all turned aside, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doest good, no not so much as one. Their throat is an open sepulcher; With their tongue they have used deceit; the poison of the asp is under their lips: Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness: Their feet are swift to shed blood: Destruction and misery are in their ways."

And then Paul could have mentioned what he said in Romans 6:23: "The wages of sin is death." Pay Day is coming some day. Colossians 2:12 would help him understand how he could be forgiven and given the hope of eternal life. "Having been buried with Him in baptism, wherein ye were also raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. And you, being dead through your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, you I say did He make alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our trespasses; having blotted out the bond written in ordinances which was against us: taking it out of the way nailing it to His cross."

#### **SELF-CONTROL**

How do you talk to someone about self-control who always gave free rein to any and every temptation they ever had?

Paul might have started with Proverbs 25:18: "He that hath no rule over his own spirit is like unto a city that is broken down and without walls." It appears that such a person is absolutely defenseless before any and every assault of the Devil.

Paul may have instructed Felix and Drusilla with a device he, himself used when he said in 1st Corinthians 9:27, "But I buffet my body, and bring it under subjection: lest after having preached unto others, I myself should be a castaway." Paul uses a boxing term here. He says, I am not just shadow boxing, this is a real fight, as my spirit pounds away at my flesh, and I intend to go the distance.

We are exhorted in Romans 6:12: "Let not sin reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey the lusts thereof." And then in verse 16, "Know ye not, that to whom ye present yourselves unto obedience, His servants ye are whom ye obey."

One of the greatest example of self-control is in the life

of our Lord Jesus Christ. In Matthew 27:12-14 we read: And when He was accused by the chief priests and elders, He answered nothing. Then saith Pilate unto Him, "Hearest thou not how many things they witness against thee?" And He gave him no answer, not even to one word: insomuch that the governor marveled greatly. But Jesus held his peace? I wonder how many listening at this time, can join me is saying: "I wish I had that kind of self-control."

#### THE JUDGMENT

And then the third point naturally follows when Paul speaks to Felix and Drusilla concerning the Day of Judgment. He could have told them of several things Jesus said about the judgment. In Matthew 16:27: "The Son of man shall come in the glory of His Father and His angels; and then shall He render unto every man according to his deeds." Matthew 12:37: "By thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned." John 12:48: "He that rejecteth Me, and receiveth not my sayings, has one that judgeth him: the word that I spake, the same shall judge him in the last day."

Felix and Drusilla were no doubt reminded of what Paul said in Acts 17:31, "God has appointed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom He hath ordained; whereof He hath given assurance unto all the nations in that He hath raised Him from the dead." God does not want us to forget that it is a man who will judge the world: a man who has earned the right to judge since He endured all the temptations that come to us, and was victorious.

Then no sermon on the judgment could have been complete without Paul telling what John would say later on, in his own description of the Judgment in Revelation 20, "And I saw a great throne, and Him who sat upon it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no room for them. And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne; and books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged according to the things which are written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead that were in it; and death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. And death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death, even the lake of fire. And if any was not found written in the book of life he was cast into the lake of fire." There is a warning that needs to be heeded by all that think of the Judgment Day in Amos 4:12 when the prophet says: "Prepare to meet thy God."

#### CONCLUSION

As Paul finished his message, Felix trembled and answered, "Go thy way for this time; and when I have a convenient season, I will call the again unto me." He hoped withal that money would be given him of Paul, wherefore also he sent for him the oftener, and communed with him. He was looking for a bribe from Paul that was never offered. This went on for two years, and Felix never trembled again. We read in James 2:19, "thou believest that God is one: thou doest well: for even the demons also believe, and shudder." Someone has written these unforgettable lines.

Tomorrow he promised his conscience, Tomorrow I'll mean to believe. Tomorrow, I'll think as I ought to think, Tomorrow, my Savior receive. Tomorrow, tomorrow, tomorrow, thus day after day it went on. Tomorrow, tomorrow, tomorrow, till youth like a vision was gone. Till age and his passions had written, this message of fate on his brow; And forth from the shadows came death, with the pitiable syllable Now.

# Ike & Lee's Update

Soul Winning: We began our souls winning this year with a strategy to look again around us, in the vicinity where we live and the nearby towns and villages. So now we go preaching the Gospel in the nearby villages once again after evangelizing these villages and the neighborhood some 10 or so years ago and the result we are getting is very encouraging. We now go on Tuesdays and return the next day. This works for us because Tuesdays and Fridays are market days in our area and so all the villages folks travel to our town (Bawjiase) to sell their farm produce so there wouldn't be, many or any one in the villages from the morning till the evening. In the evening all the village folks will assembled to watch a Gospel Film Show and to listen to the word of God. A strategy we have adopted to attract more people to listen to us. This strategy helped us start the year with a total of 8 souls baptizing through our ministry in January 2009. All these new converts will be worshiping with us at Park Side Church of Christ (PSCC)

<u>Church Planting</u>: We are also working on to start the congregation at Agona Nkwanta this year. The only problem is still how to support the one to lead that congregation when it is started. As of last December 2008, the Fianko Church of Christ is self-supporting after only 2 years. There is also the "unexpected church" which we have told you about that needs help in leadership, a place to meet, and Bibles in our Local languages for most of our converts in these villages can't read the English Bible.

Our visit to the "unexpected church" was successful with 36 people in attendance, it was Saturday so that was no a problem. However, the actual members in attendance were 21. Church attendance at Park Side Church of Christ was the lowest ever recorded in our 6 years 7 months old in existence. We were 41 adults of which only 35 were members. There were over 8 funerals in town and that caused the low attendance. The economic situation too is a factor but yes or no, we are on.

We truly have a long way to go if we are to achieve our dream of planting Churches of Christ in every village and town in GHANA.

<u>Bible Lessons</u>: We are still enrolling and mailing lessons (Studies in the Bible) out to students. Just this morning before leaving home to mail this report we received a box full of 100 copies of completed lessons 1-5 Studies in the Bible from a Pastor from his church members from a village that are ready to send to GIJAPA for grading.

## BREAKING THE ICE

#### From GIJAPA Newsletter March 1979

Once during my ministry we have had to break the ice to baptize a person. This seems on the face of it a chilling experience and I would not argue the point. Some seem to think that since the Lord has told us to baptize and to be baptized that no dire side effects will take place. The Lord will see to it that we do not get sick. However, a miracle is not needed in such cases to keep the person being baptized from getting sick.

Water freezes at 32 degrees, so no matter how cold it is the water can't get any colder than that. The people who suffer from the cold are the people who may stand on the bank in zero weather. If it is zero as far as the air is concerned, then the people watching are 32 degrees colder than the person in the water. No special miracle is needed to keep the watchers from getting sick, so we would suppose that none would be needed for the person in the water. But whether you get sick or not, is not the point. The Lord has commanded it and so it must be done. However most people today don't have to worry. The building is usually warmed to about 72 degrees and the water is heated, so that it is just right. No one has to get the least bit chilled. We do it right. One time I started to go into the baptistery to baptize and had to back out for awhile. The water was hot, almost hot enough to scald. But we managed to get the job done. After all, hell will be a lot hotter. E.B.
