

Back in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and sixty-two, I was bringing a message on the seventh chapter of the Gospel according to Matthew. It started out with judge not that ye be not judged - then on to cast not your pearls before swine - then to the memorable verses that altered my life completely: "Ask and it shall be given you, seek and ye shall find, knock and it shall be opened unto you. For everyone that asketh receiveth, and he that seeketh findeth, and to him that knocketh, it shall be opened!"

It was at this point that I challenged the congregation at the First Church of Christ in Lynchburg, Ohio where I was preaching at the time in this manner. We don't have to ask God for anything that we can do for ourselves. Where we need God's help is in the areas beyond our reach. We need help to do impossible things. Let's all go home today and ask God for the impossible. I don't know whether anyone took me seriously or not, but I took myself seriously and went home and prayed that God would give me this radio ministry - GOD IS JUST A PRAYER AWAY. In this way with only a small number of the BIG stations we could cover an area greater than the area of several hundred regular powered outlets.

During the night time hours, especially our programs on the super stations can be heard over an area of about thirty-five states each. The money involved would be astronomical, but Jesus said, "Ask and it shall be given you, seek and ye shall find, knock and it shall be opened unto you." The existence of this ministry is ample proof that the Lord honored His word and gave us what we asked, sought, and knocked for. For if ye being evil know how to give good gifts unto your children how much more shall your Father who is in Heaven give good things to them that ask Him. We asked and He gave. Shortly after that my prayers began to be answered when I went and talked to WCKY about available radio time. On October 26, 1962, I received a letter that I almost threw away. It was from WCKY, a 50,000 watt radio station in Cincinnati, Ohio, telling me that the time we had asked about was available. I almost threw the letter away because the price they were asking for the half hour time segment at 7:30 on Sunday night was out of my reach—impossible—\$182.00; I was thinking of \$40.00 as impossible. We are no longer on WCKY; we switched to WLW within the year, and a half hour segment today on WLW at 6:30 AM is \$1,100 and a half hour segment at 8 AM on WLW is \$1,300 - now that seems impossible, but YOU make it possible!

After carrying the letter around about a week, I started to throw it on the fire with some trash I was burning. Then I thought it might not be fair to do it without showing it to my first wife, Roberta. When I showed it to her she said, without any hesitation, that we could do it. She got on the phone and began to call a few preachers and told them the story - how we could broadcast the gospel over a twentyfive sate area on Sunday night. But everyone else said it could not be done that I had two strikes against me: No one knows you and you have no money.

To make a long story short, that is how it all began. I almost threw the letter away, but didn't. My career from that moment in the Lord's work is hinged on the fact that I did not throw that letter away. The Ministry has grown

since and now instead of one program we have ten on the super power 50,000 watt stations, plus the 5 short wave stations that were featured in the March GIJAPA newsletter. Many have been won to Christ and the good that has been done will only be known on that Great Day.
