

## THIS IS MY STORY

Chronicles 4:20


I was reading from I Chronicles 4:10: "And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, "Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my border, and that thy hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it be not to my sorrow!" And God granted him that which he requested. I read it over again and again. I liked Jabez's prayer and I committed it to memory and began praying it every day that God would indeed enlarge my borders as well as GIJAPA's. I added Proverbs 16:3 to my daily prayers too: "Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and He will establish your plans."

I'll admit this time last year; I was scared as I began my day to day responsibilities for GIJAPA. However I could still hear Ed say, "Be strong, always take time to exercise and Pray! Keep GIJAPA going as long as the money comes in to pay the bills. And don't forget, GIJAPA began with prayer and was sustained by daily prayer for 50 years." I hid his words in my heart and never forgot them! On Tuesday March 27, 2012, I was checking my email after praying and walking two miles; not recognizing the name Jeremy P. or KDWN as the subject, I hit delete. As quickly as I deleted I hit restore. Why? I'm not sure! The email read like this: "Dear Pastor Bousman, I recently noticed your ministry's radio program on several full time 50,000 watt stations. We own a time period on another 50,000 watt 'Skywave' station reaching most of the west coast. I am writing to determine if you have interest in broadcasting your ministry program on this station: KDWN AM 720 Las Vegas, NV "Talk of the West" Sunday 10:30-11:00 p.m, \$145/per 30 minutes. If you have any interest in this please let me know. Best regards, Jeremy" I

replied with, "Yes, send coverage map and see if you can get the price reduced." The cost of the other stations we're on, range from \$320-\$1300 per/30 minute broadcast. He sent the coverage map and an offer of \$140. We began broadcasting on Palm Sunday in Las Vegas! Two days after signing that contract Jeremy notified me of a 10:30-11:00 p.m. broadcast out of Lexington, NE covering the rest of the west coast for \$185 per week. I replied, "Send coverage map and see if you can get the price lowered." Two days later, he sent the map and said, "How does \$160 sound?" I replied with, "PTL, YES!" We started broadcasting on KRVN April 15, 2012.

Ladies and Gentlemen, this kind of growth for GIJAPA in a week's time for \$300 is humanly speaking unexplainable, it's impossible, it's a MIRACLE - it is an answer to Jabez's Prayer, which I had made my prayer! God listened, God heard, and God answered! He extended our borders from coast to coast. What a mighty God we serve! All too often we are guilty of limiting God with our small prayers. I still pray Jabez's Prayer every day and I thank God for blessing GIJAPA over and above anything I ever dreamed possible.

We are reminded once again that KDWN and KRVN coverage is as big a miracle today with GIJAPA finally being heard Coast to Coast as it was 50 years ago when Ed challenged his congregation in Lynchburg, OH to go home and pray for something impossible based on Matthew 7:7-8. "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened." That day he prayed for a nationwide radio broadcast. I believe God just finished answering Ed's prayer. It took 50 years, but it was worth the wait! I rejoice on this anniversary of Ed's crossing over Jordan on his journey home-May 16, 2011. My fears have been replaced with faith. I know without a doubt that "I can do all things through Christ Jesus who strengthens me." \*\*Xaomi\*



### KDWN and KRVN takes GIJAPA COAST to COAST

Opportunity to expand GIJAPA's reach to the west coast came from much prayer, faith, and your continued contributions. The addition of two 50,000 watt radio stations, KRVN 880 on the AM dial and KDWN 720 on the AM dial has GIJAPA broadcasting during the night and reaching Coast to Coast. Broadcasting at night increases the coverage because radio waves can travel further due to the changes in the Earth's ionosphere when the sun is absent. KRVN based in Lexington, NE is the rural voice of NE owned by more than 4,000 farmers and ranchers. KRVN can be heard in: AR, CO, ID, KS, MO, NE, NV, NM, ND, OK, SD, TX, UT, WY, and Mexico. KDWN, "Talk of the West" in Las Vegas, NV bridges the western gap. KDWN can be heard in these Western states: AR, CA, ID, MO, NV, NM, OR, UT, WA, WY, Mexico, and British Columbia. In the words of Ed Bousman, "Praise the Lord and Pass the Ammunition!"
