In May of 1938 (age 19) the Virginia State Track Meet

was held on the facilities of the University of Virginia in Charlottesville. Most of the team had gone up on Friday, and the coach told five of us who were distance runners to wait until Saturday morning to drive up from Newport News, about two and half-hours away.

While I was not a very faithful Christian at the time and seldom attended services, I did a strange thing before I left home on Saturday morning. I kneeled down privately and prayed for safety. About two hours later we were involved in a wreck about fifteen miles from Charlottesville. The car I was riding in was totaled and observers marveled how anyone could come out of it alive. One of the injuries was the loss of half of the middle finger on my right hand.

Was the outcome luck or was it something else? The scripture does say of angels: "Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to do service for the sake of them that shall inherit salvation?" Whatever your opinion may be the fact is I was in Bible College the following year studying (I use the word studying loosely) for the ministry.

On the masthead of the monthly newsletter for the GIJAPA radio program is the emblem of a right hand with the missing middle finger, a continual reminder that the only reason I have



for being alive and surviving my teen-age years is to preach



the gospel. I have done very little in the ministry except to preach and this for over sixty (67 when he passed away-May 16, 2011) years. Whatever good has been done is known only to the Lord, but at least at this point we can say that because of prayer, the grace of God, and the ministry of angels many thousands in many parts of the world have heard the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ that would never have heard otherwise.

JUNE 11th, 1939

Philippians Chapter Four

Ladies and Gentlemen, on Sunday morning June, 11, 1939, I was awarded a small pocket size New Testament by the preacher of the Twenty-fourth Street Church of Christ in Newport News, Virginia. The occasion was my gradua-

tion from the local High School. The preacher had several scripture references written on the presentation page. The references were from the book of Philippians, chapter four, and verses thirteen and nineteen. The first one is where Paul says; "I can do all things in Him that strengtheneth me." The second one says, "And my God shall supply every need of yours according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.'



These verses were certainly needed at that time. It was the middle of the Great Depression when twenty percent of the work force had been out of jobs. I had declared myself for the ministry and had no money, no job, and no prospects that things were going to be any better. That preacher certainly picked the right verses at that time. For Paul to say he could do all things was a pretty tall order. But how could he do all things under the conditions when he lived? He had no car, no plane, no printing press, no television, no radio, no publishing house, no church building, no computer, no email, no cell phone, and think of it no internet where Paul like some preachers today could download ready-made sermons and not have to get up any of his own. Yet he said he could do all things. How could he do all those things without those modern hi-tech advantages? He explained how he did it when he said he could do all things through Christ who strengthened him. That other verse said, "My God shall supply every need of yours according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus." Think of it, Paul says that God will supply our every need. We need to remember that God will decide what we need and not ourselves. Now that was a good verse for my preacher to write when he gave me that New Testament, June 11, 1939.

HOW LONG WILL IT BE?

Back in 1939 I went to the hospital to see our preacher who was in the hospital as a patient. Now the reason our preacher was in the hospital was because his throat had been cut, almost from ear to ear. Before I continue with this story, I must tell you first how he got his throat cut. He did not get his throat cut by the elders, nor was it the deacons who individually or collectively did him in. Actually they were well qualified officers of that church. I just wanted to establish the innocence of these brethren of that bygone day, all of whom have gone on to their reward. The reason his throat was cut was because of a doctor. You see, our preacher had an ingrown goiter, and hence the necessity of the operation. So, it was on this occasion that I went to see him. Now it looked like at that time that our world was falling apart. World War II was ready to begin; in fact it did begin about a month later on September the first 1939. I remember the headlines on the newspaper that day: "WAR BEGINS IN EUROPE!" Now on this visit to see my preacher, I asked him if he knew how long it would be before the Lord would come, because it looked like it would happen at any moment. I did not want the Lord to come back at that time, because I was getting ready to go to Bible College, and I did not want the Lord to return before I had a chance to do something. The preacher said, "He did not know when the Lord would return, and that if anyone said they knew when He would return they would be making a fool of himself." This was not good enough for me, and I insisted on an answer that would be a little more definitive. I said, "Well how long do you think it will be? I don't want you to make a fool of yourself, but could you make a guess?" He gave that question some thought and then ventured to say, "Well I think the way things are going, and he gave himself plenty of leeway, we may have fifteen years yet." I took that as the gospel truth and rejoiced that I had fifteen years to preach the word. Surely in fifteen years I ought to be able to do something for the Lord in the matter of the salvation of the souls of men. Now that was 1939, and at this writing this is November 2006. Now I realize that most of you who went to school since about 1970 never learned to add, subtract, divide, or multiply, but if you will just take your pocket calculator and punch in 4 x 15 the read out will reveal that fifteen years has passed by four times, and just about half of the fifth fifteen year increment. My preacher was right. He said the Lord would come in 15 years. The only thing is, he did not say which fifteen years. As we approach the year 2007, world conditions look as bleak as 1939, and many are asking me when will the Lord return. Well I have to say: "A man makes a fool of himself if he thinks he knows when the trumpet will sound, and the Lord shall descend from heaven with a shout, and the voice of the archangel." However if you really want to know: considering world conditions, just how long I really think we have left? I have to say, I truly believe the Lord will come within fifteen years, the only thing is, I am not saying which fifteen years it will be. It may be this fifteen years, or the next one after that, or the next one after that, or the next one after that, and after that you don't need to know because none of you will be here. However a more important question remains: "If you are not here, WHERE WILL YOU BE?" E.B.
